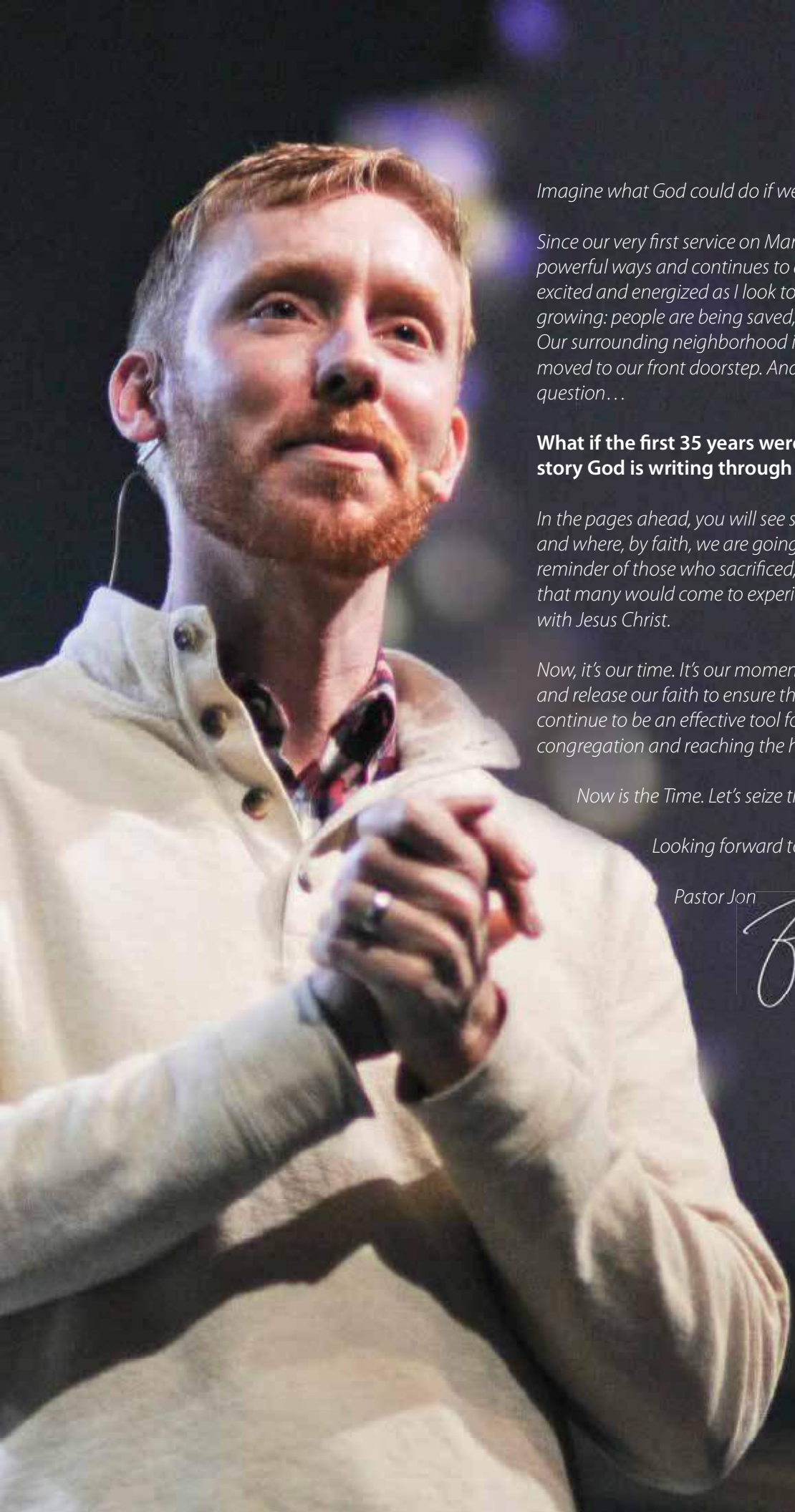
Seizing the moment, securing our future!

History of Giving and Building

1996



Breaking New Ground

On March 8, the groundbreaking ceremony for Phase I of the building took place at the "Field of Dreams". That campaign allowed us to build our very first Auditorium, where the present-day Student Center is located.

1999



The Journey Continues

God abundantly blessed The Journey Continues campaign, which raised \$8.75 million for Phase II. Our current Auditorium was built during that campaign.

2003



Press On

Just as The Journey Continues came to a close, the Phase III campaign was launched. The joke became that The Journey Continues...and continues...and continues. That \$10 million campaign built the Atrium and created the space that we call Discoveryland.

2011



The 15:8 Project

Phase IV was our last major building campaign. That \$14 million campaign renovated the Student Center, opened the balcony in the Auditorium, upgraded our technology, and built the Prayer Tower.

Now is the time to expand our capacity to welcome those seeking the hope that only Jesus provides.

GOAL 1



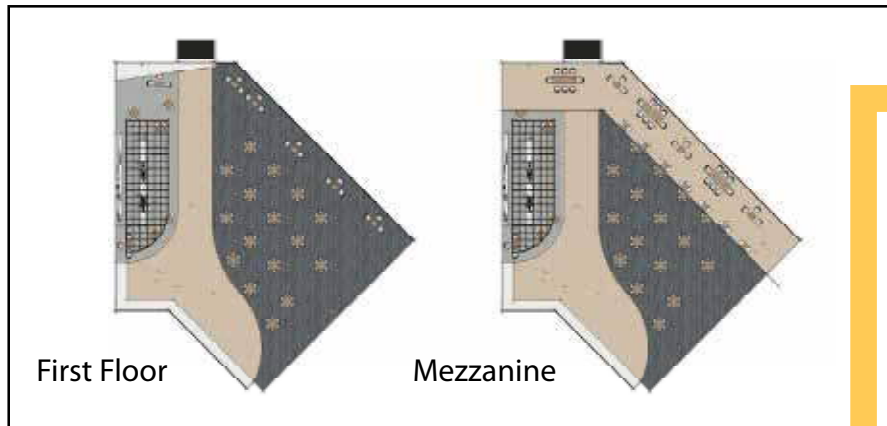
Now is the time to create welcoming spaces that promote ministry and show good stewardship.



- By creating a facility that is safe and welcoming, we invite everyone to participate fully in worship and community life.
- Our church building requires thoughtful renovation to continue serving its ministry purpose effectively. Our spaces are more than just rooms. They are more than just places to house the building's mechanical and technical systems. Our spaces are the physical embodiment of our ministry, the very spaces through which our congregation's conversations and connections flourish and deepen.
- Updating our facility demonstrates good stewardship of the resources God has entrusted to us. By modernizing outdated spaces and systems, we reduce maintenance costs, improve energy efficiency, and ensure our building serves us effectively for generations to come.
- When we update and maintain our meeting spaces, building, and grounds, it communicates that we believe the Word of God is alive and active - it is not some relic from the past.

Atrium Redesign & Refresh

GOAL 1



Now is the time to invest in spaces that facilitate the conversations, connections, and community that are central to our church's mission and growth.



- Redesigning our Atrium and Coffee Shop represents an investment in the vital conversations and connections that strengthen our church family.
- A warm, remodeled gathering space with a coffee shop communicates hospitality and helps visitors feel comfortable as they navigate their first experiences with our church.
- Beyond home and work, people need a comfortable “third space” to gather with friends, read, work, or create. Our Atrium and Coffee Shop can serve as this space for people in both our congregation and the surrounding neighborhoods.

Children's Ministry Refresh

GOAL 1



Now is the time to ensure our physical spaces support the vital spiritual work happening in our children's ministry.

- Modernized children's areas can incorporate the latest safety features and security protocols to give parents peace of mind while their children are in our care.
- Updated spaces will be designed with specific age groups in mind, creating environments that engage children at their developmental level and make Bible learning more effective and memorable.
- Refreshed and expanded children's areas allow us to welcome more families and accommodate future growth in our congregation.
- For many families, the children's ministry area is their first and most important touchpoint with our church. Vibrant, well-maintained spaces communicate that we value children and prioritize their spiritual formation.
- By investing in our children's ministry spaces, we're not just updating rooms—we're creating environments where life-changing conversations happen, where young faith takes root, and where the next generation of believers begins their journey with Christ.

Chapel Construction

GOAL 2

- A Chapel creates a dedicated space that has a more appropriate atmosphere for weddings, funerals, and special prayer services where the Auditorium might feel overwhelming.
- A Chapel allows multiple ministry activities to occur simultaneously on our property, maximizing our ability to serve different groups within our congregation and community.
- By investing in a Chapel today, we're creating a legacy of faith that will serve our children and grandchildren, providing them with a special place to encounter God for years to come.

- Our church community needs dedicated spaces that support our mission and ministry. A Guesthouse represents an opportunity to extend our reach and deepen our impact in ways that complement our existing campus.
- A Guesthouse provides a welcoming space for visiting missionaries, guest speakers, and ministry partners, demonstrating our commitment to hospitality while reducing accommodation costs.
- A Guesthouse can serve multiple functions—housing for ministry interns or staff in transition, a place for counseling sessions, a youth gathering space, or a retreat location for leadership planning.

Now is the time to consider how a Guesthouse could enhance our ability to serve, connect, and grow as a church family while being good stewards of our resources.

How do I get involved?

Creative Gift

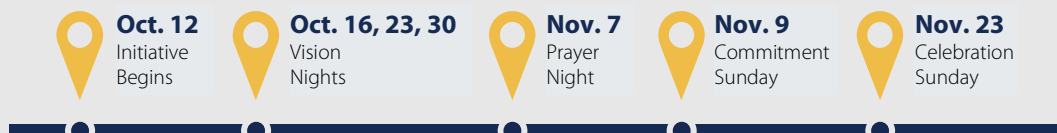
Consider giving things other than money. (For example: stocks or proceeds from the sale of other assets.)

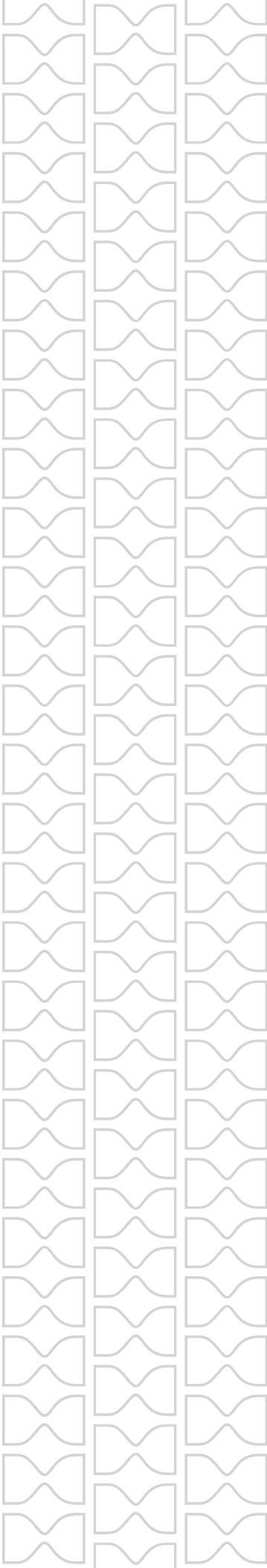
- You can write a check. Put "Now is the Time" in the memo.
